Everything You Need to Know (Except the Answers)

Entry Cost and How to Pay

- There's nothing to pay upfront. At the end of the night, there'll be a suggested donation for each player to make, and we'll explain how.
- The suggested donation will start at \$10 but it may go up and down a little for different players along the way! Keep track of this with pen and paper – but don't worry: it will just be a suggestion.

What You'll Need:

- A laptop (or other computer) that can join a long Zoom meeting:
 - With a decent internet connection and battery-life or wall-plug.
 - With large enough screen & audio so your whole team can see and hear well.
- A second device for entering in your answers. A smartphone should be fine for this. (Or you could use the same computer as above with a second browser tab on a second monitor.)
- THE LINK to get to the quiz (We'll email it to you a few days beforehand).
- A pen and paper (as above) and all your own drinks and snacks.

Whom To Invite:

- Anyone, really! Most of the questions won't require Bible or church knowledge, so non-church friends are welcome. They'll just need to be comfortable enough with the event being a fundraiser for Crossover which is focused on helping Australian Baptists Share Jesus.
- Kids are welcome, but there won't be child-focused questions or WA would win since it will be before kids' bedtime there. And we can't have WA winning everything.

How It Will Work:

- On both of your devices (e.g. laptop and smartphone), you'll follow THE LINK to the Quiz Page.
- On the Quiz Page, there'll be a button for joining the Zoom meeting – only hit that on your **Zoom Device**. Once admitted, open the Chat side-bar so you'll be able to read as well as hear questions. Change your Zoom 'Name' to the name of your church.

- (If your Zoom connection fails during the night, just return to THE LINK and re-enter. Then use the Chat feature to ask the hosts for any questions you missed.)
- On your **other device**, ignore the Zoom button, and fill in your team details.
- Forget fancy team names – your team will just be the name of your local Baptist Church.
- You'll then be taken to a form ready for your Round 1 answers.
- Your answers will be marked by a computer, so you'll need to spell them correctly. But don't worry about case sensitivity, or whether an answer like "Summertime" is one word or two. We're training our marking robots to overlook all that.
- At the end of each round, when you hit the 'Submit' button, you'll instantly get your results for the round and your score and rank. You'll also see the next round's answer-form there and ready for you.
- There'll be a Leaderboard on the Zoom screen showing the top 10 churches, and also the State Association table. (Even if your team isn't in the top 10, you'll see your score and rank on your answer-giving device.)
- How will we know you're not cheating? Well, we trust you to do the right thing. But keep all your team on camera the whole time so you'll always feel seen by us as well as by God.

Churches Entering More Than One Team:

- More than one team from a single church is fine. Each team will see their own individual score. The church's score will be average of its teams' scores.
- All teams from the same church should use the **same church name** e.g. "Smithville Baptist". However, different campuses of multisite churches are welcome to name themselves separately.
- You could even have multiple tables in the same room with a large screen, sharing the Zoom connection, but each table entering its answers on their own device (e.g. smartphone).

Well that was a lot. But it will be worth it! Keep an eye on your inbox for THE LINK, a few days beforehand. Looking forward to seeing you there at the inaugural Australia's Baptistist Quiz Night!
